## Guideline on learner feedback consultation

(The following process was devised by Sherrard Street Youthreach Centre)

- Focus group/s formed to obtain general feedback on learners' experience of the SEN Initiative in the centre. Ideas are recorded on a flip chart and typed up afterwards. (This introduces the process to the learners and tunes them into what the SEN Initiative means in their centre.)
- 2. Learners are asked to consider what qualities they consider make a good mentor. On a large piece of paper (flip chart sheet) they share a marker to write down in single words or phrases a list of qualities. This is done as a collaborative exercise. The list is typed up afterwards.
- 3. This exercise is repeated with the learners now considering the qualities that make a good mentee.
- 4. Sitting at a table, the learners are shown the accompanying questionnaire. The questions are read out loud to the group as they fill it in. The information from the questionnaire is collated and recorded.
- 5. A similar questionnaire is devised for any other major intervention that the SEN Initiative funds (for example, in Sherrard St they have a substance use reduction resource worker).
