Erasmus+ is the European Union Programme for education, training, youth and sport.

- \* **EU FET = VET and AE Funding Opportunities** <u>are separate</u> **VET and Adult Education -** Check out the : <u>Jargon Buster Leargas</u>
- \* Who Can Take Part in a Mobility Project? Post Primary, VET and Adult Education Staff
- \* What kind of activities? Job-shadowing; Teaching assignments; Courses and training; VET institution or another relevant organisation based in an <u>Erasmus+ Programme country</u>.
- \* Other Activities: Invited experts (2 to 30 days); Hosting teachers in training; Preparatory visits
- \* Two main types of Erasmus+ Adult Education projects: Learning Mobility for Individuals' and '
  A short secondment period; Job-shadowing; Attendance at workshops or courses; Attendance at a staff training week Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices;

  - \* Environmentally sustainable and responsible practices
  - \* Digital transformation in education and training
  - \* Participation in democratic life

- \* Attach supporting documents
















#### **Potential Project Topics**

After you submit your project, your colleague will receive a notification in their eTwinning Live to accept it. Once they accept the project invitation, the project will have to be approved by the National Support Services of both countries.




