EU Working group for schools: Learning for the Green Transition and Sustainable Development

Ireland recently hosted a Peer Learning Activity (PLA) for the EU Working group in Kinsale. The focus of the two-day meeting was partnerships and collaboration, and a range of speakers presented to our European colleagues including Professor Paul Walsh, Green Schools, ECO-UNESCO, Take 1, World Wise Global Schools, GENE, Irish Schools Sustainability Network (ISSN). Kinsale Community School who co-hosted the meeting demonstrated their partnerships with the community and with the local college of Further Education. The students talked about their Student Council, and individual students talked about some of their achievements including their success in BTYSTE and ECO-UNESCO Young Environmentalist Competitions in recent years. In his keynote address, Professor Paul Walsh, said:

'A whole of society's effort needs to create coherent pathways from pre-school, primary, secondary, higher education and into careers that reflect lifelong learning on how to care for each other and the planet. This requires all of us to go back to school.'

Lord David Puttnam was a keynote speaker, and said that our response to the climate crisis *'will require a global and whole-of-society response. Our children and our grandchildren will be the judges and possibly the victims of our degree of vision and our commitment.'*

We would like to thank the European Commission for inviting Ireland to host this event, and a particular thanks to the management of Kinsale Community School, and its students for pulling out all the stops to make it an informative and enjoyable meeting for our colleagues from across Europe.

Schools in Ireland are doing fantastic work in the area of ESD and it is great to get the opportunity to showcase and celebrate this work.

2. School Sector - Climate Action Mandate

Under the Climate Action Plan, all public sector bodies are required to comply with a Public Sector Climate Action Mandate with the exception of some specified organisations including schools for whom a separate mandate would apply.

The School Sector – Climate Action Mandate was published on 14 March: <https://www.gov.ie/en/publication/337b6-public-sector-climate-action-mandate/>. One of the requirements in the Mandate is that schools adopt a Sustainability Policy Statement. A working group has been established by

the Department to develop templates and guidelines to support schools in adopting their statement. Details will be sent to schools and published on the ESD webpage and in the ESD Newsletter in due course.

We know that many schools right across the country are doing great work in the area of ESD and Sustainability. The purpose of the template and guidelines will be to assist schools in identifying actions that they are already taking, and articulating them in a Sustainability Policy Statement in as easy and as straightforward a way as possible.

4. Research Funding - IRC New Foundations 2023

The Irish Research Council's New Foundations is a key driver in progressing strategic priorities by enabling awardees to pursue research, networking or dissemination activities within and across the diversity of disciplines. The scheme provides support for:

- research actions;
- the development of networks and consortia;
- conference;
- workshop development;
- capacity building for interdisciplinary collaboration.

Strand 4b: Education for Global Citizenship and Sustainable Development
New Foundations Awards in partnership with the Department of Foreign Affairs (Irish Aid), the Department of Education and the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth.

Supporting research, networking and collaboration for the purpose of increasing public awareness and understanding of issues such as climate change, hunger, global inequality and injustice, these awards will be 12 months in duration up to a maximum value of €10,000.

One award will be dedicated to education for Global Citizenship and Sustainable Development in the Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) sector.

5. Early Learning and Care – Green Energy and Retrofit Grants

The Minister for Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth, Roderic O’Gorman, has announced the allocation of €9million in grant funding for 141 early learning and childcare services under the Building Blocks – Improvement Grants across two strands: Green Energy, and Retrofit.

Grants are being provided for improvements to increase energy efficiency, and utilising renewables where feasible, such as the installation of solar panels and heat pumps, insulation and water conservation measures. The Retrofit strand will support the upgrade of works including kitchens and refurbishment, and the upgrading of sanitary facilities, roof repairs/replacement and flooring.


GreenComp Community of Practice

8. ESD in County Donegal – Green Hub Pilot Initiative in Donegal Town

Leas-Chathaoirleach of Donegal County Council, Micheál Naughton, recently launched the Donegal Town Green Hub with local businesses and organisations showing great interest.

The Donegal Town Green Hub pilot was officially launched on Tuesday 28 February in The Abbey Hotel in Donegal Town. This initiative is led by Donegal County Council in partnership with the Regional Waste Management Planning Offices supported by the Local Enterprise Office, Donegal ETB, Donegal Town Community Chamber and the Donegal Town Business Focus Group. Over 30 businesses and organisations were represented at the launch, showing an incredible interest in learning about sustainability actions for business. Through the support of the Donegal ETB the Abbey Vocational School, Donegal Town, the Further Education & Training Centre, Drumcliff, Donegal Town and the Donegal ETB, Further Education & Training (FET) Services, Ard Scoil na gCeithre Máistir Tir Chonail St., Donegal Town are all involved in the initiative.

The Green Hub Pilot Project is aimed at encouraging businesses and organisations to implement good waste management practices, particularly in the areas of waste segregation and recycling. Currently, 70% of the material found in commercial general waste bins could be diverted to the food and recycling waste streams. It is hoped that this pilot will showcase with improved practices in the workplace, that this figure can be greatly reduced, and whilst not only increasing recycling rates, will also aid Ireland's transition towards a Circular Economy.

This initiative delivered by the Regional Waste Management Offices and funded by the Department of Climate Action, Communications and the

Environment.





9. ESD in County Dublin – Relove Fashion and Rubbish Film Festival

Relove Fashion at the Rediscovery Centre

"Once upon a time, there were two fashion seasons: Spring/Summer and Autumn/Winter. Fast forward to the present day, and the fashion industry is churning out 52 "micro-seasons" per year. With new trends released every week, the goal of fast fashion is to compel consumers to buy as many garments as possible, as quickly as possible. Due to this overconsumption and unsustainable resource use, the fashion industry is one of the most environmentally degrading industries on the planet, accounting for a significant amount of carbon emissions, water usage, pollution, as well as multiple social and workers rights issues. In order to achieve our Sustainable Development Goals for 2030, it is essential to promote sustainable fashion practices and educate young people so that they can develop as innovative and conscious decision-makers.

The Rediscovery Centre, the National Centre for the Circular Economy in Ireland, is at the forefront of this movement, championing sustainable living, promoting greener low-carbon practices, and encouraging lifelong learning. We bring together the skills and expertise of artists, scientists, designers and craftspeople united in a common purpose of sustainability. Located in a

bespoke demonstration eco-facility, we operate a multi-faceted visitor Centre and unique social enterprises that champions and highlights the actions required to achieve a circular economy. This includes a range of educational and research programmes, a shop, a cafe, and four workshops: Rediscover Furniture, Rediscover Fashion, Rediscover Paint, and Rediscover Cycling. Our workshops provide training and courses related to reuse, repair, resource efficiency and low carbon living, and utilise unwanted materials for new product development and design.

One of our notable projects is the Relove Fashion competition, a sustainable fashion competition developed with the Eastern and Midlands Waste Region local authorities. The competition challenges secondary school students to explore creative reuse options such as upcycling, repairs, alterations, and mending, inspiring them to take a closer look at how their clothing is made. To enter the competition, students must use their creative design skills to create a sustainable, washable and wearable outfit using clothing sourced from a charity shop, swap shop, or reused items already available at home. By providing students with an opportunity to showcase their creativity while promoting sustainable fashion practices, the competition encourages a shift towards a more circular and sustainable economy.

Every year, we are blown away by the creativity, sustainability, and innovation of the applicants. Out of this year's 22 finalists, six winners were chosen for the following categories: Best Casual, Best Evening, Best Tailoring, Best Research, Most Innovative, and Overall Winner. Finalists repurposed fabric from jeans, ties, curtains and other innovative sources to create their designs.

Dublin City Rubbish Film Festival

On 17 April 2023, the inaugural Dublin City Rubbish Film Festival Awards presentation was streamed live online.

The Rubbish Film Festival, now in its eighth year, is an Irish initiative that provides a really unique opportunity for young people to showcase their creative abilities, raise awareness about environmental issues such as Climate Action, and develop new digital storytelling skills. TY students from invited secondary schools can attend the workshop, which is funded by their county council, and then enter their film at the festival.

This year, schools in Dublin participated in the festival for the first time, which was introduced on a national scale with 52 schools from six counties. A total of 28 videos were created, with involvement from 15 Dublin City secondary schools!

Each participating school was represented by a group of 12 pupils.

[Createschool](#) offered a two-day intensive session on-site at their school to help these teams acquire and/or enhance their filmmaking skills. During the program, they created their own quick, ONE-MINUTE film or films in order to raise awareness of sustainable and environmental issues among their peers.

Coming up with concepts, creating scripts, practicing, filming, producing, and editing are all part of the workshops. Students have complete artistic freedom over their work. The movies are created using digital mobile technologies. The young people then presented their videos and a poster they had designed for their film to a panel of judges from Dublin City Council.

All students received a Certificate for their TY Portfolio, and awards were custom-designed by the Rediscovery Centre in Ballymun for the winning and runner-up entries.

The award winners are now entered in the first National Rubbish Film Festival Awards which will take place in the Solstice Arts Centre In Meath on 3 May.

1. The Bottle, a film produced in St. Stephen's Green by Loreto College.
2. Clogher Road Community College - runner-up.

10. Upcycling at Malahide Portmarnock ETSS

Applied Technology students at Malahide Portmarnock Educate Together Secondary School have spent the past year upcycling material in their project work.


At the beginning of the year, the school received new whiteboards which came with a lot of packaging waste. The cardboard waste was easily recycled, however, the timber frames around the whiteboards contained staples and as a result, these were unable to be recycled.

To avoid the timber going into landfill and to promote a more circular economy, students have been using these timber frames to construct projects. So far this year students have created clocks and boats using this timber and they are currently working on a lamp project which will see them through to the end of the year. This is a remarkable achievement as it means that the school did not have to purchase any timber this academic year and all the waste from the whiteboards has been recycled or upcycled thus avoiding landfill.

Although the timber from the whiteboards will be exhausted, the Technology Department have acquired doors which were being thrown out of a church, and these will be used in student project work next year. The Technology Department and its students will continue searching for more timber waste

that can be upcycled as they are keen to prevent valuable material going into landfill.

12.Picker Pals at St. Paul's National School, Roscommon

“Children from second class in St. Paul's NS, Castlerea, Co. Roscommon proudly took part in this year's Picker Pals project. We have found it to be a very worthwhile extension of our Green Schools and SESE curriculum and a most enjoyable experience for the children.

Registration was very simple and the pack received is colourful, informative and fun. The children thoroughly enjoyed dressing as a class in hi-vis and raising awareness locally of the simple act of cleaning litter from our

13. Hedgerow Planting at Kinsale Community School

"This year's TY Sustainability Option at KCS focused on the theme of biodiversity. The group participated in an excellent Citizen Science programme facilitated by Wild Work, during which students were taken out to different habitats to identify various pollinator species, insects and trees. Following this, the students felt inspired to continue last year's work of improving and enhancing the biodiversity in the school and they decided to plant more trees on campus."

A suitable area alongside a fence on the school campus was found and students began to research suitable native hedgerow tree species and how to plant them. They measured the site to calculate spacing and how many trees would be needed.

During the school's annual Green Week in March, two tree planting days were held. Having learnt how to plant bareroot trees on the first day, the TYs used their experience to become peer educators showing first and second year CSPE classes how to do it, and on a cool bright Monday morning in March around 70 trees were planted. After planting, the young trees were mulched with pieces of cardboard to stop weeds and grass growing around them.

Hedgerows are hugely important for biodiversity providing food and habitats for pollinators, birds and small mammals. Every year in Ireland up to 3,000 km of hedgerow are destroyed, so planting hedgerows is an excellent opportunity to counteract this loss. It is also beneficial for hands-on outdoor learning, for teamworking and for empowering students, helping them to understand how they can take action for climate and biodiversity. The newly planted hedgerow now consists of approximately 130 native tree species: a mix of hawthorn, blackthorn, hazel, holly, elder, guelder rose, crab apple, spindle, rowan and bird cherry all of which were chosen for their benefits for biodiversity."



14. ECO-UNESCO – Young Environmentalist Awards 2023

ECO-UNESCO is Ireland's leading youth environmental education organisation. For more than 35 years, it has been providing quality environmental education programmes and resources to young people in schools, youth groups and community groups throughout Ireland.

ECO-UNESCO's vision is to promote sustainable lifestyles through

education and awareness. We aim to achieve this by providing high quality programmes and resources that encourage young people between the ages of 10 to 25-years to take responsibility for their environment and live lives that are healthy and sustainable.

Its' lead programme is the Young Environmentalist Awards Programme (YEA). Established in 1999 as part of the UNESCO/ECO-UNESCO International Network of Environmental Educators (INEE), this programme has engaged over 50,000 young people in environmental action to date. The purpose of this initiative is to inspire young people from all over the island of Ireland to take positive environmental actions by engaging in activities related to sustainable development issues such as climate change, biodiversity, energy conservation, or water conservation.

The awards aim to promote the importance of environmental awareness and action. It also aims to increase young people's knowledge of the environment, encourage them to take positive actions, build their self-esteem and develop their abilities as leaders within their schools and communities.

The awards are open to all young people aged between 10-18 years. The YEA programme provides an opportunity for every young person in Ireland to become a 'Young Environmentalist' by taking part in a variety of positive environmental actions throughout the year.

The YEA encourages participants from a variety of settings including schools, youth groups and community groups in various age groups, from Super Junior (10-12), Junior (12-14) and Senior (15-18).

The semi-final rounds of the YEA competition are known as ECO-Dens, where 150 groups from across the country are chosen to present their environmental projects at Dragons' Den style events to a panel of experts

including representatives from the Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Education, and the Department of the Environment. Four rounds of ECO-Dens take place during March and April, with events in Leinster, Munster, Connacht and Ulster.

This year, ECO-Dens events were hosted all across Ireland. Climate-conscious students from schools across Ireland including Drimnagh Castle Secondary School, St Joseph's Secondary School Rush, and Marino College, showcased projects focusing on a range of issues such as waste, climate change, biodiversity and marine life. Based on the young people's presentations to the judging panel, a selection of the semi-finalists will then be shortlisted to go forward to the final showcase event, which will take place in Dublin in late May.

Elaine Nevin, National Director of ECO-UNESCO, commented:

'We are now in our 23rd year of the Young Environmentalist Awards, and each year it is so heartening and encouraging to see the standard of action projects continue to rise, along with the young peoples' enthusiasm and creativity. Young people are so passionate about environmental issues and are extremely engaged and motivated to take climate action.'

The Awards are a fantastic way for young people to channel their energy into ideas and creative solutions to tackle climate issues, and we are delighted to provide them with a platform to do so. The presentations to the judges as part of the ECO- Dens have been fantastic – so the panel will have a tough job on their hands deciding on the shortlist. All the participants should be extremely proud of their work, and I hope that they continue to collaborate with us and each other to take positive environmental action.'

15. BTYSTE Irish Aid/Self-Help Africa Science for Development Award Showcase

The Minister of State for International Development and Diaspora at the Department for Foreign Affairs, Sean Fleming, hosted the Science for Development Showcase in Iveagh House on 22 March 2023. Eleven inventions that could be used in the Global South were selected from this year's BT Young Scientist and Technology Exhibition (BTYSTE). Irish Aid, in collaboration with Self Help Africa, has been organising the Science for Development Award at the BTYSTE since 2006.

This year's winners were Vedh Kannan and Will Carkner from Sutton Park School. They created a portable diagnostic device that could diagnose

diseases including malaria and leukaemia. The device allows blood samples to be tested for disease with 94% accuracy. Crucially, it does not require doctors to administer, potentially increasing access to testing in low-income countries. The winners receive a perpetual trophy and a €7,000 bursary for the students and their teacher to travel on a fact-finding/field testing visit to a country in Africa.

Other projects on display included an eco-friendly wind turbine created by Sara O'Beirne from Mohill Community College in Leitrim, that uses wood instead of fiberglass to generate energy. Jasper Ryan, Seán Brennan and Shreyash Shukla from Athlone Community college investigated the use of the black soldier fly as an eco-friendly source of protein. Oscar Green from Kinsale Community College in Cork looked at using the kinetic energy created by people walking on a school hallway to power a school.

At the showcase, the students met with aid professionals and academics to discuss their projects and future plans. Among those in attendance was Dr. Tony Scott, co-founder of the BTYSTE. 
The Water Forum are the national statutory body representative of all

Concern about methods with which to incorporate ESD in university curricula is widespread. Much attention is focused on the “what” and “how” of such a strategy, in terms of the structure, techniques, tools, and competencies needed for ESD in different disciplines (Tejedor, Sánchez-Carracedo and Segalàs, 2022). Ireland’s National Strategy on Education for Sustainable Development (2014 - 2020) aims to ensure that our education system contributes to sustainable development by ‘equipping students with the relevant knowledge (the ‘what’), the key dispositions and skills (the ‘how’) and the values (the ‘why’) that will motivate and empower them throughout their lives to become informed active citizens who take action for a more sustainable future (DoE, 2014: 3). By 2030, it aims to ensure that all students acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development and to work to achieve the goals of sustainable development through ESD (United Nations, 2015). ESD is therefore recognised at an international, European and National level, as being an essential contributor to all efforts to achieve the UN 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

This webinar aims is to develop an ESD curriculum design framework for academic staff to incorporate ESD into their curricula within Irish Higher Education Institutions. It will also create a best practice framework for ESD across higher education programmes in Ireland which have a clear alignment with the NTUTORR deliverable of ‘developing a curriculum framework for digital transformation, resilience, and sustainability in higher education’. Finally, it will provide a great opportunity to collaborate on the initial design of the ESD elements of the NTUTORR curriculum framework.

Keynote speakers include; Dr. Maria Kirrane (UCC), Dr Cormac McMahon (TUD), Dr John Scahill (ATU) and Ms Kayleigh-Ann Myles (Lawlers

Sustainability).

28. HEA Healthy Campus Conference

The first national wellbeing conference ‘*Supporting Success through Wellbeing in Higher Education*’ organised by the HEA was held in Dublin on April 20th, 2023, with Síle Seoige as MC. The aim of the event was to highlight the importance of wellbeing in relation to the mission of higher education including key enablers such as leadership, strategic planning and a whole campus approach, with a focus on the Student Mental Health and Suicide Prevention Framework and the Healthy Campus Charter and Framework.

Over 100 HEI and HECA representatives attended the event, including the Healthy Campus Advisory Group (THEA, IUA, USI, Dept. of Health, HSE, DFHERIS) Healthy Campus Network and staff and students working on health and wellbeing. Posters showcasing of the ongoing excellent work

taking place across the sector were displayed and the full 'Healthy Campus Case Studies' can be view on the [Healthy Campus](#) webpage.

In the opening address, Minister for Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science Simon Harris TD noted that *'we have a massive opportunity to help turn the dial and create a country where health and wellbeing is at the core of the graduates and next generations we produce'*.

There were keynote talks from Professor Christiane Stock, Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin on ***'Study conditions and mental health in higher education in Germany - Implications for healthy campus initiatives*** and Professor Margaret Barry, University of Galway on ***'A Mental Health Promotion Approach to Wellbeing in Higher Education'*** -

A highlight of the day was the launching of the [Eurostudent 8 Irish Report](#) by Valerie Harvey, Head of Performance Evaluation at the HEA. Valerie presented data relating to student mental health and wellbeing, including the broader determinants of health. Also launched on the day was the HEA funded PCHEI mental health Project ***'Identify and Respond'*** which supports institutions' implementation of the National Student Mental Health and Suicide Prevention Framework.

This was a 'healthy event' which included stretch breaks and a facilitated lunchtime walk, participants were invited to stand at any point during presentations. A key takeaway was the importance of leadership to progress the agenda to not just 'bolt on' but to 'bake in' wellbeing into institutions everyday business.

29. Biodiversity – Citizens Assembly Final Report

The Final report of the Citizens Assembly on Biodiversity was published on 5 April 2023. The report was produced as a result of seven meetings of the Assembly from May 2022 through to the end of January this year. It concluded with the 99 members of the Assembly agreeing 159 recommendations. These include 73 high-level recommendations and 86 sectoral specific actions and priorities which have the potential to dramatically transform Ireland's relationship with the natural environment.


Two actions relate specifically to ESD:

Children and young people are integral to ensuring the environment is protected. In line with the current National Strategy on Education for Sustainable Development – ESD to 2030, the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth with the Department of Education, the Teaching Council, the National Council for Curriculum and Assessment, and the Teacher Education Support Service(s) should continue to engage in meaningful curriculum reform and teacher education to explicitly incorporate teaching and learning on biodiversity in early childhood, primary and post-primary curricula.

In line with the current National Strategy on Education for Sustainable Development - ESD to 2030, the Department of Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science and relevant agencies, such as the National Skills Council, Regional Skills Fora, Expert Group on Future Skills Needs, SOLAS etc., should work with further and higher education providers to develop a greater number of easily accessible further and higher education programmes, apprenticeship and community-based education related to biodiversity and environmental sciences.

30. Children and Young People's Assembly Report

The **Children and Young People's Assembly** on Biodiversity Loss convened in October 2022 and brought together 35 young people aged 7 to 17 from across the country over a number of weekends to explore and discuss the protection and restoration of biodiversity in Ireland. The Assembly arrived at a number of calls to action in the areas of Education and Raising Awareness as well as Governance, Energy and Transport, Waste and Consumption, Restoring and Rewilding, Habitat and Species protection and Overexploitation.

31. Research – Decarbonizing Methods Workshops - NUIG

The topic of Decarbonizing Research Methods provided the focus of two interdisciplinary workshops (in-person/hybrid and online, respectively) on the 18th and on the 25th of November 2022, organised by Dr Ashley Cahillane and PhD scholar Laoighseach Ní Choistealbha. The idea behind the workshops was to prompt interdisciplinary discussion about challenges and possibilities for decarbonizing research itself - from research travel and fieldwork to data storage and lab equipment.

The workshops were held in the University of Galway and hosted by the Moore Institute for Research in the Humanities and Social Sciences, the Insight SFI Research Centre for Data Analytics, and the Irish Humanities Alliance. The workshop attracted participation from approximately 40 researchers from all disciplines in the University of Galway as well as other universities across Ireland and further afield (Canada, Germany, North America and the United Kingdom).


Workshop participants had the opportunity to discuss the carbon management of their own research methodologies and advance ideas about how the research undertaken in their institutes could be decarbonized. For example, discussions included the need for funding streams to invite considerations about the carbon impact of research projects. Presentations and panel discussions, involving a variety of scholars and experts from the

humanities and sciences, fuelled the workshop conversations.

A variety of outputs has emerged from the workshops, including [a blog on the Irish Humanities Alliance](#), [a blog on the Moore Institute website](#), and a practical [list of policy recommendations on decarbonizing research in our universities](#), which can be found on the University of Galway [Sustainability website](#). 32. UN IPCC Report: Climate Change 2023

A major UN “report of reports” from the authoritative Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), outlines the many options that can be taken now, to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and adapt to human-caused climate change.

The study, “released on 20 March 2023 following a week-long IPCC session in Interlaken, brings into sharp focus the losses and damages experienced now, and expected to continue into the future, which are hitting the most vulnerable people and ecosystems especially hard.

34. Cineáltas: Action Plan on Bullying

The Implementation Plan for *Cineáltas* was published on 10 April 2023. The Implementation Plan commits to implementing each of the 61 actions contained in *Cineáltas* within a five-year period.

Cineáltas: Action Plan on Bullying was published on 1 December 2022. *Cineáltas* is the Department of Education's whole-education approach to preventing and addressing bullying in schools.

Cineáltas is dedicated to the prevention and addressing of bullying, cyber bullying, racist bullying, gender identity bullying and sexual harassment,

among other areas, in schools.

It is centred on a child right's based approach and provides a collective vision and clear roadmap for how the whole education community and society can work together to prevent and address bullying in our schools.

An Implementation and Evaluation Group is being established to oversee implementation of the actions and the publication of annual implementation and evaluation reports, informed by feedback from children and young people, parents, school staff, education partners, key stakeholders and relevant agencies.

A youth advisory group is being established to support the implementation of *Cineáltas* and will play a key role in ensuring the successful implementation of all these actions.

Implementation of the actions in *Cineáltas* has already started:

- The Department has recently established a Student Participation Unit, which will promote the participation of children and young people in the development of department policy, building on its existing work in this area
 - An Expert Group has been established to advise the Department on how best the Student Participation Unit can progress its work. Professor Laura Lundy, Professor of Education Law and Children's Rights at Queen's University who developed the Lundy Model of children's participation will chair this Expert Group
 - Work to update the anti-bullying procedures for schools is well underway with Continuous Professional Development and training being developed for all school staff, Board of Management members and parents
-

- €5 million is being invested to pilot a programme of counselling supports for primary school students. This will serve to support the very positive work which already takes place in the area of wellbeing in schools. The details of the programme are currently being finalised

The Department looks forward to working with the whole education community to build on the work already done to ensure that all the children and young people who attend our schools are kept safe from harm and that the wellbeing of our children and young people is at the forefront of everything that we do.



35. Climate Postcard Exchange 2023

The second instalment of the creative postcard exchange took place between October 2022 and March 2023 with the theme of 'Climate Change' being at the forefront of all activities. Students from schools all across Ireland and the United Kingdom took part and created works of art to visually represent their ideas in terms of sustainability, climate justice, deforestation and effects of wildlife.

Support and funding provided by the British Council Ireland and British Embassy Dublin offered the organiser, Fergal Kilkenny - Art Teacher from St Louis Secondary School, Dundalk, the opportunity to offer on-site and online external engagement opportunities to schools and expand the network from

26 to 37 schools. New schools were recruited through social media and reaching out to UK colleagues through representative organisations such as NSEAD and INSEA.

Given the distance between participating schools, it was decided to offer a number of online opportunities to engage with climate related content. These took the form of a webinar provided to the network by the National Gallery of Ireland based on 'Turner: The Sun is God exhibition', and a Climate Action workshop facilitated online by the Rediscovery Centre (a centre for the circular economy in Dublin). These alongside physical interactions offered the students involved an opportunity to learn, create and meet other participants in the project.

The exhibitions of students work, some 760 postcards, was exhibited in the British Embassy Dublin. The exhibition was opened by British Ambassador Paul Johnston and attended by special guest Ryan Tubridy. Students how took part in this creative endeavour and their teachers got to see their work outside of the classroom, in wonderful showcase of their creative talents.

The exhibition then travelled to the United Kingdom and was exhibited in Leicester Grammar School.

36. Free Bike Library Scheme – National Transport Authority

The free bike library scheme in Harold's Cross Educate Together has been such a phenomenal success that it is being [rolled out to 20 more schools](#) across Dublin!

The scheme works by allowing parents to borrow electric bikes, mostly cargo bikes, for up to three months at a time as an alternative to car journeys to and from school.

It has been operating in Harold's Cross Educate Together school since the start of the school year in September and since then the school is "almost car-free – all the parents are cycling or walking their children to school".

The school was chosen due to major issues in the mornings as the road outside is narrow and traffic backs up quickly. 10 schools will be added to the scheme before the summer and another 10 in the Autumn. Each school will be given a selection of bicycles free of charge to parents. If it is a success in those schools, it will be extended nationwide next year.

The initiative will cost about €500,000 and is being funded by the National Transport Authority.



37. GAA Green Clubs - Supporting Sustainable Development

GAA club representatives from across the island of Ireland have signed up to Phase 2 of the GAA Green Club Programme to commit to action in their clubs and communities to combat climate change and protect their natural

environment.

The GAA Green Club Programme, which has been running since January 2021, provides practical support and guidance to GAA clubs in raising awareness and implementing environmentally sustainable actions in their clubs and communities. The programme is founded in the GAA's status as a UNSDG Champion for Goals 3 - Good Health & Wellbeing, 4 – Quality Education, 15 - Life on Land and 17 - Partnerships.

During the programme's pilot phase, 40 pioneering Green Clubs implemented a range of actions across the areas of Energy, Water, Water, Biodiversity and Travel & Transport to enhance the sustainability of their grounds and games, to engage their membership in sustainability action and to future-proof their grounds against the impacts and challenges of climate change.

Clubs like Buncrana (Donegal), Affane-Cappoquin (Waterford), Middleton GAA (Cork), Ballycumber (Offaly), Park-Rathensika (Laois) and Clarinbridge (Galway) have undertaken green actions large and small, from gear swaps and banning single-use plastic bottles to community river-bank restoration projects, from pitch and clubhouse energy upgrades to tree-planting, and from creating biodiversity-rich walkways to running safe cycling programmes.

A pioneering Club for the programme has been Mullingar Shamrocks, who through the leadership of their Healthy Club Officer, Joan Crawford Ormsby, developed a Biodiversity Walkway around their playing field alongside the banks of the river Brosna. Everybody is noticing the developments as Mullingar Shamrocks have embraced the importance of biodiversity. Unsurprisingly the educational sector has taken note.

“One of the primary schools, about 200 metres away, their teachers are coming down, using the walkway for nature studies,” Crawford Ormsby says.

“St Colman's National School brought the kids down for a nature walk and treasure hunt. You have lots of other uses for this walkway, it is for the community, not just the Gaelic community”.

“We have very good programmes going on in Transition year of Mullingar CBS, we are hoping to do Phase Two next year of our Tidy Towns project. We'd be hoping to link in with the TY's and the active retirement group 1428, here in Mullingar.”

“We want to do biodiversity friendly initiatives with a local business and the active retirement group. We want to hook those groups up with local primary schools.”

Over 200 clubs are signed up to the next phase of the Green Club Programme in an 18-month commitment that will see each club form a Green Team, develop a sustainability action plan and adopt a Green Club charter before becoming certified as an official GAA Green Club.

Clubs are encouraged to form a Green Team and to include a younger member in its ranks, supporting links to the formal education system and in particular the GAA/PDST Future Leaders Transition Year Programme, which as of 2023 includes a Sustainability Module.

GAA Youth Leadership & Sustainability Manager, Jimmy D'Arcy points out the relevance of the programme for Clubs and Communities alike, “The Green Club Programme is aligned to our values of Community Identity, Respect and Teamwork. Understanding the place and impact of our Clubs and activities on the Communities around us, Respect not only for each other, but for the environment we inhabit and Teamwork off the field as well as on. The programme is not only having an impact on the operation of our

Clubs but is supporting an increasing awareness and education of our members.

The new recruits to the Green Club Programme will benefit from the recently-published Green Club Toolkit – a set of simple, practical and relevant resources and case studies across the areas of Energy, Water, Water, Biodiversity and Travel & Transport developed in collaboration with expert organisations North and South and with funding from the Department of Environmental, Climate and Communication especially for the GAA’s volunteer-led context.

The GAA Green Club Programme and Toolkit have been developed in partnership with the Climate Action Regional Offices (CARO) with the guidance and expert input of Sustainable NI, the Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland, Action Renewables, the Local Authority Waters Programme (LAWPro), Uisce Éireann, NI Water, the Regional Waste Management Offices, Keep NI Beautiful, the All-Ireland Pollinator Plan, RSPB NI, the National Transport Authority (NTA), the Road Safety Authority (RSA) and the NI Executive’s Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs.





Tá sé mar chuspóir ag an tionscnamh seo daoine óga as gach áit ar oileán na hÉireann a spreagadh chun gníomhartha dearfacha comhshaoil a dhéanamh trí pháirt a ghlacadh i ngníomhartha a bhaineann le ceisteanna forbartha inbhuanaithe amhail athrú aeráide, bithéagsúlacht, caomhnú fuinnimh, nó caomhnú uisce.

Tá sé mar aidhm ag na gradaim an tábhacht a bhaineann le feasacht agus gníomh comhshaoil a chur chun cinn. Spreagaimid rannpháirtithe ó réimse suíomhanna lena n-áirítear scoileanna, grúpaí óige agus grúpaí pobail in aoisghrúpaí éagsúla, ó Shárshóisir (10-12), Sóisir (12-14) agus Sinsir (15-18).

Tugtar ECO Dens ar na babhtáí leathcheannais de chomórtas YEA, áit a







Tá sé dírithe ar chur chuige atá bunaithe ar chearta an linbh agus soláthraíonn sé fíis chomhchoiteann agus treochlár soiléir maidir leis an mbealach ar féidir le pobal uile an oideachais agus leis an tsochaí oibriú i gcomhar chun bulaíocht a chosc agus dul i ngleic léi inár scoileanna.

Tá Grúpa Forfheidhmithe agus Measúnachta á bhunú chun maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar fhorfheidhmiú na mbeart agus ar fhoilsiú na dtuarascálacha bliantúla ar fhorfheidhmiú agus ar mheasúnacht a gcuirfidh aiseolas ó leanaí agus ó dhaoine óga, tuismitheoirí, foirne scoile, comhpháirtithe oideachais, príomhpháirtithe leasmhara agus gníomhaireachtaí ábhartha bonn eolais fúthu.

Tá grúpa comhairleach don óige á bhunú chun tacú le forfheidhmiú *Cineáltas* agus beidh ról tábhachtach aige maidir lena chinntiú go gcuirfear na bearta seo go léir i bhfeidhm go rathúil.

Tá tús curtha cheana féin le forfheidmiú na mbeart in *Cineáltas*:

35. Malartú Cártáí Poist Aeráide 2023

Bhí an dara babhta den mhalartú cártáí poist cruthaitheacha ar siúl idir mí Dheireadh Fómhair agus mí an Mhárta 2023 agus bhí an téama 'Athrú Aeráide' chun tosaigh sna gníomhaíochtaí go léir. Ghlac scoláirí ó scoileanna ar fud na hÉireann agus na Ríochta Aontaithe páirt ann agus chruthaigh siad saothair ealaíne chun a gcuid tuairimí a léiriú go físiúil i dtaca le hinbhuanaitheacht, ceartas aeráide, dífhoraísiú agus tionchair ar an bhfiadhúlra.

Thug an tacaíocht agus an maoiniú a chuir an Chomhairle Bhriotanach in Éirinn agus Ambasáid na Breataine i mBaile Átha Cliath ar fáil seans do Fergal Kilkenny, Múinteoir Ealaíne as Meánscoil Naomh Louis, Dún Dealgan, deiseanna um rannpháirtíocht sheachtrach a thairiscint ar an suíomh agus ar líne do scoileanna agus an líonra a leathnú ó 26 go dtí 37 scoil. Earcaíodh scoileanna nua trí na meáin shóisialta agus chuathas i dteagmháil le comhghleacaithe sa Ríocht Aontaithe trí eagraíochtaí ionadaíochta amhail NSEAD agus INSEA.

Ó tharla go raibh an oiread sin achair idir na scoileanna rannpháirteacha, cinneadh roinnt deiseanna ar líne a thairiscint chun a bheith rannpháirteach in ábhar a bhain le haeráid. Is mar sheimineár gréasáin a chuir Dánlann Náisiúnta na hÉireann iad sin ar fáil don líonra agus iad bunaithe ar 'Turner: Taispeántas The Sun is God', agus ceardlann ar Ghníomhú ar son na hAeráide a bhí á éascú ar líne ar an Ionad Athaimsithe (ionad don gheilleagar ciorclach i mBaile Átha Cliath). Thug siad sin chomh maith le

hidirghníomhaíochtaí fisiceacha deis do na scoláirí rannpháirteacha foghlaim a dhéanamh, a bheith cruthaitheach agus bualadh le rannpháirtithe eile sa tionscadal.

Cuireadh na taispeántais de shaothar na scoláirí, tuairim is 760 cárta poist, ar taispeáint in Ambasáid na Breataine i mBaile Átha Cliath. D'oscail Ambasadóir na Breataine, Paul Johnston, an taispeántas agus d'fhreastail Ryan Tubridy air mar aoi speisialta. Bhí na scoláirí a ghlac páirt sa saothar cruthaitheach seo agus a gcuid múinteoirí ábalta a saothar a fheiceáil taobh amuigh den seomra ranga, i sárthaispeántas iontach dá dtallanna cruthaitheacha.

Tugadh an taispeántas chuig an Ríocht Aontaithe ansin agus cuireadh ar taispeáint é i Scoil Ghramadaí Leicester.

Is mian le Fergal Kilkenny buíochas a ghlacadh le hAmbasáid na Breataine i mBaile Átha Cliath agus leis an gComhairle Bhriotanach in Éirinn as a gcuid tacaíochta don tionscnamh seo - gan iad ní fhéadfaí tionscadal den chineál sin agus an rannpháirtíocht ghaolmhar a chur i gcrích.

Le linn chéim phiolótach an chlár, chuir 40 Club Glas ceannródaíoch raon gníomhartha i bhfeidhm i réimsí a bhaineann le Fuinneamh, Uisce, Bithéagsúlacht, Taisteal agus Iompar chun inbhuanaitheacht a bpáirceanna agus a gcluichí a fheabhsú, chun go mbeadh a gcuid ball páirteach i ngníomh inbhuanaithe agus chun féachaint chuige go seasfaidh a gcuid páirceanna an aimsir in aghaidh na dtionchar a bheidh ag an athrú aeráide agus in aghaidh na ndúshlán a bhainfidh leis.

Tá clubanna amhail Bun Cranncha (Dún na nGall). Áth Mheáin-Ceapach Choinn (Port Láirge), CLG Mhainistir na Corann (Corcaigh), Béal Átha Chomair (Uíbh Fhailí), Páirc -Raithín an Uisce (Laois), agus Droichead an Chláirín (Gaillimh) tar éis gníomhartha glasa, idir bheag agus mhór, a dhéanamh. Ina measc sin tá babhtáil fearais, buidéal phlaisteacha aonúsáide a chosc, tionscadail um athchóiriú bruach abhann, uasghrádú fuinnimh ar pháirceanna agus ar chlubthithe, cur crann, bealaí siúil atá saibhir ó thaobh na bithéagsúlachta de agus cláir um rothaíocht shábháilte a reáchtáil. Bhí Seamróga an Mhuilinn Chearr mar chlub ceannródaíoch don tionscadal, a d'fhorbair bealach siúil Bithéagsúlachta thart timpeall ar a bpáirc imeartha le hais bhruacha na Brosnaí, trí cheannaireacht a nOifigigh um Chlub

Sláintiúil, Joan Crawford Ormsby. Tá gach duine ag tabhairt na bhforbairtí faoi deara mar go bhfuil glactha ag Seamróga an Mhuilinn Chearr le tábhacht na bithéagsúlachta. Ní haon ionadh go bhfuil sé tugtha faoi deara ag earnáil an oideachais.
