Create a Baseline

- **Develop a shared vision**: Have a dedicated learning and teaching group working on mapping current school practice under each principle.
- **Identify and engage stakeholders:** UDL implementation requires the participation and collaboration of a wide range of stakeholders, including learners, teachers, parents and Principals/Deputy Principals.
- **Build capacity:** UDL implementation requires teachers to have the knowledge, skills, and mindset needed to support diverse learners. Learners need the skills sets to effectively engage with the choices on offer.
- **Provide resources**: UDL implementation requires a range of resources, including materials, technology, the built environment, and staff to support the needs of ALL learners.
- **Foster collaboration** and partnerships: Collaboration and partnerships: look for opportunities to include learner voice in the planning. Have schools share practice internally and with each other.
- Monitor and evaluate: Regular monitoring and evaluation of your school implementation plan. Collect data on learner outcomes and feedback from stakeholders to identify areas for improvement and make any necessary adjustments to the plan.
